Tuesday, June 2

**Raft the Upper Uncompahgre River** from the town of Ridgway to the Ridgway Reservoir on this 2 hour guided rafting trip! (Class II to III rapids) The majestic San Juan Mountains fill the back drop for the entire run! Float through prime wildlife habitat for an up-close look at songbirds, deer, and birds of prey!
